The Pastor Search Committee of Dalraida Baptist Church (DBC) sought God's leading to help us understand the kind of man He is preparing to lead our congregation. DBC is searching for a pastor who is committed to the inerrancy and authority of the Bible. He will agree with the Baptist Faith and Message 2000 (<https://bfm.sbc.net/bfm2000/>) and will lead Dalraida Baptist Church on the strong foundations of biblical authority. Being kingdom-minded and having a heart for the lost, he will also be missional, evangelistic, and a discipler, willing to partner with denominational entities, other churches, and ethnic congregations.

Dalraida's next pastor must be a transformational leader who connects with all ages, is approachable, and is accessible. He must have vision, excitement, humility, transparency, vulnerability, grace, accountability, and a teachable spirit. This leadership will be modeled at home, among the staff and members, and throughout denominational entities.

Spiritually, the pastor will establish and guide the discipleship and evangelism strategy for every age group of the church, engaging people in corporate worship, encouraging them to grow spiritually, connecting them in serving opportunities, and challenging them to fulfill their God-given mission to make disciples. He will strive to maintain a unified worship experience with other staff members and ministry leaders.

Administratively, the pastor will partner with staff and lay leaders to ensure staffing, facilities, and programs align to best meet strategic goals. He will oversee budgets and provide oversight and direction in the financial functions of the church.

At Dalraida Baptist Church, it's the "Dalraida difference" that separates us from other churches of similar size. DBC is a debt-free multi-generational church with an average attendance of 150 (pre-Covid 220). In addition to our Sunday morning worship service, DBC also has weekly Sunday School classes, Sunday evening Bible studies, and Wednesday evening activities for all ages. Our most recent pastor retired after serving for 23 years and we are currently praying and seeking for the man God has to lead our church moving forward.
